- Understand how these measurements relate to each other.
- Learn which strike weight curve best suits a given instrument and how to calibrate hammerheads accordingly.
- Discover how strike weight and action ratio work together to create a balanced touch and pleasing tone.
- Calculate and install the correct key leads, taking lever and key weight into account — for each individual key.

Learn the theory, understand the mechanics, and master the practice!
